She had some choice words for the folks who won't turn off their digital devices, the ones who give TSAs a hard time and travelers who get way too drunk during the flight. And she didn't hold back when it comes to loud kids on a plane.

There are times you may be indifferent about her rants (yes, Whoopi, I am one of those people who waves my hands about when I'm near a smoker) and other times you want to give her dap (newbies call it "fist bumping") for saying exactly what you were thinking -- for me it was why it's not okay to talk out loud on a cell phone during a movie.
